1) CALL TO ORDER

a) Staff update regarding Community Center building upgrades and new staff hires.

Utilities Manager Bartels and Library Director Bruner introduced new staff, and provided an update on the Community Center remodel that will be discussed by Town Council on 4/25.

5) COMMITTEE CHAIR REPORT

Donna Armstrong reported on her research for the Town coordinating with AZ Game and Fish Department and police shooting range for conducting hunter safety courses. The Board walked and assessed the Chino Mudder course for August 2017 preparations. Details as follows:

Station No. Task(s) needed prior to August

1 Weed eating.

2 Contact Paul Tomitz, Yavapai College, about re-design and build, add poles,

pvc repair.

Consider new station between 2 & 3.

3 Contact CAL Ranch about sponsorship with water barrels – Carlos has ropes.

Weed eating, check each tire for insects.Add culverts to middle of trench for crawl.

6 Since obstacle is two-way, place orange construction fencing to separate,

direction signs.

7a NEW to be constructed – no water possible jersey barriers/concrete barriers from

Ed @ ACS Concrete.

7b On one half of wall, place foot holds and one hanging rope.

8 None needed.

9 Add ropes for tightropes (Carlos has in storage).

10 Check top knots in ropes.

11 Add/borrow straw bales again for pyramid. 12 Add webbing again, improve new banks.

Move slanted ramps closer together and paint footprints, instructional sign

needed for side-to-side motion needed.

Weed eating.

Increase water level this year.
Add ropes for a commando crawl.
Fill unneeded small trenches.

Need bigger pipes.

19 The Red Dragon – Eric will sand down rough spots, replace slats w/ 2x4s, and repaint obstacle.

Build hill at beginning with slant/slide down into water/pond (clean water due to liner again).

Other general comments and needs: Need to work with Councilman Lon Turner once again, and 7-1/2 HP pump needed for water system. Water system needs repairs by #19. Add new obstacle #7a (dry). Created numbered signs for each station. Contact Kevin Larson, LDS Church, for possible assistance with water system.
