

ORDINANCE NO. 15- 802

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF CHINO VALLEY, ARIZONA, TITLE III ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 30 GOVERNING BODY, SUBCHAPTER MAYOR, BY AMENDING SECTION 30.023 POWERS AND DUTIES, RELATED TO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DESIGNATE ANOTHER COUNCILMEMBER TO PRESIDE OVER A MEETING; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. In General.

The Town Code of Chino Valley, Arizona, Title III Administration, Chapter 30 Governing Body, Subchapter Mayor, Section 30.023 Powers and Duties is hereby amended to read as follows (additions shown in ALL CAPS; deletions shown in ~~strikeout~~):

The powers and duties of the Mayor shall include the following:

* * *

(B) He or she shall be the Chairperson of the Council and preside over its meetings. AT ANY MEETING WHERE THE MAYOR IS PRESENT AND ABLE TO PRESIDE, THE MAYOR MAY DESIGNATE A COUNCILMEMBER TO PRESIDE OVER THAT MEETING AND, UPON DESIGNATING THE COUNCILMEMBER, THE MAYOR MAY RELINQUISH THE CHAIR FOR THAT MEETING ONLY. ~~He or she~~THE MAYOR AND ANY COUNCILMEMBER DESIGNATED BY THE MAYOR TO PRESIDE OVER A MEETING may make and second motions and shall have a voice and vote in all ~~the~~COUNCIL proceedings.

Section 2. Providing for Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Providing for Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


Section 4. Providing for Penalties

Any person found responsible for violating any provision of this Ordinance section shall be subject to the civil sanctions and habitual offender provisions set forth in Section 10.99(A), (B) and (D) of the Town Code of the Town of Chino Valley, Arizona.




