**HOW TO SUBMIT A DEPLOYED INDIVIDUAL'S NAME:**

- Complete the application form entitled *Town of Chino Valley's Yellow Ribbon Honor Tree*, providing information about the individual who is deployed. Application forms are available at Chino Valley Town Hall, Chino Valley Sr. Center, Library, Human Resources, or complete online at the Town of Chino Valley website, [www.chinoaz.net](http://www.chinoaz.net).
- Submit the completed application form to the Chino Valley Town Manager's Office, 202 N. State Route 89, Chino Valley, Arizona 86323, or submit online through the Town of Chino Valley website.

**DISPLAY:**

A yellow ribbon in recognition of each deployed individual will be displayed on a tree inside Chino Valley Town Hall. The public is welcome to visit the display during hours that Town Hall is open to the public. Each yellow ribbon will indicate the individual's name, rank and military branch.

The yellow ribbon will be on display for six months. Ribbons will then be removed and stored for one year. Please contact the Town Manager's Office to pick up the ribbon.

**PROGRAM TO BEGIN:**

Applications for the Yellow Ribbon Honor Tree will be available and accepted starting May 1, 2018. The program will be administered through the Chino Valley Town Manager's office.
