- **Yavapai County Recorder, Leslie Hoffman would like to announce that the last day to vote early in-person or vote a replacement ballot is Friday, October 30, 2020**
- Voters may vote early in-person or vote a replacement ballot at the Yavapai County Recorder's Office 1015 Fair St., Prescott or 10 S. 6<sup>th</sup> St., Cottonwood Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Proper identification is required.
- All Automatic Ballots-by-Mail must be returned to the Yavapai County Recorder's Office or to an Official Ballot Drop Box location no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 2020. **Do not mail your ballot after Tuesday, October 27, 2020** as it may not arrive in time. Late ballots will not be tabulated. Be sure to sign **your** affidavit envelope with **your** original handwriting.
- Instead of mailing your voted ballot-by-mail, please consider using one of our 19 Official Ballot Drop Boxes located throughout the County. This saves our County 60¢ per ballot in tax dollars.
