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Licensing Eligibility Form

To be compliant with Arizona Statute Revised Section 41-1080 subsection C & D before issuing a license to an individual, the individual must present one of the following documents to the Town of Chino Valley indicating that the individual(s) presence in the United State is authorized under federal law:

Check the box next to the document indicating lawful presence and provide a copy of said document.

<input type="checkbox"/>	An Arizona driver's license issued after 1996 or an Arizona non-operating identification.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A driver's license issued by a state that verifies lawful presence in the United States.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A birth Certificate issued in any State, territory or U.S. possession.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A U.S. certificate of birth abroad.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A U.S. passport.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A foreign passport with a U.S visa.
<input type="checkbox"/>	An I-94 form with a photograph.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A U.S citizenship and immigration services employment authorization.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A U.S. certificate of naturalization.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A U.S. certificate of citizenship.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A tribal certificate of Indian blood.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A tribal or bureau of Indian Affairs affidavit of birth.

This provision does not apply to an individual, if all of the following apply:

<input type="checkbox"/>	The individual is a citizen of a foreign country or, if at the time of application, the individual resides in a foreign country.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The benefits that are related to the license do not require the individual to be present in the United States in order to receive those benefits.
