- All registered voters are eligible to vote in the 2022 General Election.
- Emergency Voting is available today Monday, November 7, 2022, at the Yavapai County Recorder’s Offices 1015 Fair St., Prescott and 10 S. 6th St., Cottonwood through 5pm.
- Vote Centers will be open tomorrow from 6AM – 7PM. Visit www.yavapaivotes.gov for location information and identification requirements.
- **DO NOT MAIL** your voted ballot as your ballot will not arrive in time and late ballots will not be tabulated.
- All voted ballots must be hand delivered to the Yavapai County Recorder’s Office, to an Official Ballot Drop Box, or a Voter Center location no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022. Be sure to sign **your** ballot affidavit envelope in **your** original handwriting.
- Please consider using one of our 19 Official Ballot Drop Boxes located throughout the County. This saves Yavapai County 65.5¢ per ballot in tax dollars.
